

2018 STATE WHO AWARD CRITERIA

State WHO Awards judging rules:

1. Nominations shall be submitted to the Service Center Council Awards Committee by the Chapter.
2. Any CTA member is eligible for nomination.
3. Nominees are considered on the following basis:
 - A. Rendering exceptional professional/education service in two or more of these categories:
 - i. Local governance bodies/committees;
 - ii. CTA governance bodies, committees, Service Center Councils and task forces; and
 - iii. NEA governance bodies.
 - B. A nominee need not have won a Chapter WHO Award to be eligible for the CTA State WHO Award if the Chapter President, Director or Executive Board Member gives concurrence.
 - C. Only **one** State Award may be selected annually from each Service Center Council.
 - D. A member may receive the State WHO Award only **once**.
4. The attached "point system" is used to select the State Award recipient. A minimum of one hundred seventy-five (175) points is necessary for consideration.
